### **Race 4 Tattenhall**

#### **Race Information Sheet**

- Date:** Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> January 2019, 11:00am
- Venue:** Tattenhall Recreation Club – Field Lane (off Burwardsley Road), Tattenhall, Chester, CH3 9QF
- Parking:** The club is just on the edge of Tattenhall village. There is some parking to the rear of the recreation club, but if this is full, or you wish to get away promptly once other runners may still be coming in, we suggest you park in a safe location along Tattenhall Road (our marshals will direct you). Please car-share to reduce pressure on spaces.
- Facilities:** We have toilets within the recreation club. Water will be provided at the end of the race and there will be hot drinks and a charity bake sale for NEWSAR (North East Wales Search and Rescue).
- Warming up:** We ask that you avoid warming up in large groups as the road will be open right up to the race start and this may cause a danger to / from vehicles. Please, of course, be courteous to others on pavements.
- Course:** The race is run on the usual route of just over 6 miles. We will stop traffic for the first 1 mile of the course. The middle 3 miles of the route are hilly and picturesque, winding through the relatively narrow lanes of Burwardsley. However, as with many of the rural lanes around Cheshire, please be aware that there are some potholes – these are not very visible when roads are wet – please take care, especially when running in groups / overtaking.
- Weather:** The lanes around Tattenhall are prone to getting treacherous in icy weather, so please check on the borders league website and with your club captain if the weather forecast is for poor conditions.
